“The Chubbville”

All the local old-timers know that the old stone house across the street is called “The Chubbville House. It was built c. 1760 and was the first tavern in the area. It received its nickname long ago when the innkeeper was caught watering down his liquor with water from the spring that still runs through the basement of the house. It seems he poured a drink using the watered-down liquor for a patron who promptly discovered a small minnow (also known as a “chub”) floating in his glass!
